Firstly I should like to pay tribute to former chorister Barry Smith who died recently after a short illness.

Barry, the brother of Associate Member and former choir mum, Pam Kell, was a chorister and 'corner boy' from 1940 to 1945 and sang under the direction of Dr Albert Tysoe.

He attended the inaugural reunion of the ECA in 2007 and since that time has been a significant contributor to the Cathedral Choir archive being established by the ECA, especially remembering the names of his fellow choristers in the various choir photographs.


